

AUSTRIAN RESERVISTS IN WESTERN CANADA RECEIVE INSTRUCTIONS

Winnipeg, July 29. — A partial mobilization order in connection with the Austrian-Servian war has been issued, to apply in Western Canada. The order is dated July 26. George Reininghaus, Austrian consul, said there are 150,000 Austrians in Western Canada, and those concerned would be notified individually by letter that their corps had been ordered to the front.

Proclamations as to mobilization will be published in the German and Ruthenian newspapers of the West tomorrow. The Winnipeg consulate has jurisdiction over Austrian interests in the three prairie provinces, there being an honorary consulate in Vancouver for British Columbia.

There are also a large number of Serbs in the West, but there is no consul at Winnipeg.
