

# ORDERS TO AUSTRIANS

**Subjects of Emperor Francis-Joseph in  
Western Canada Asked to Join  
Their Respective Corps**

WINNIPEG, July 28.—A partial mobilization order in connection with the Austro-Servian war has been issued, to apply in Western Canada. The order is dated July 28.

George Reinshausen, the Austrian Consul, said today there were 150,000 Austrians in Western Canada, and these would be notified individually that their corps had been ordered to the front.

The proclamation as to mobilization will be published in the German and Ruthenian papers of the West tomorrow. The Winnipeg Consulate has jurisdiction over Austrians in the three Prairie Provinces, there being an Hungarian Consulate in Vancouver for British Columbia.

There is a large number of Servians in the West, but there is no Consul at Winnipeg.
