

Ottawa Poles and Ukrainians Warlike.
Ottawa, July 29.—Crying "revenge against the "tyranny and oppression" of Russia, about two thousand Poles and Ukrainians, members of the revolutionary party of this former principality, held a mass meeting here to-night. The Ukrainians formerly numbered about half the inhabitants of Russia, but are now scattered all over the world, about 300,000 living in Canada. In view of the present imminence of war in Russia, the present meeting is exceptionally significant. Much enthusiasm was shown by the members present, and furtherance of steps against the czar and his ministers, should Russia enter the Austro-Servian embroglio, was discussed.
