

## ABOUT 200,000 NATIVES OF AUSTRIA-HUNGARY HERE

CHIEFLY IN THE WEST—GER-  
MANS 410,000, BUT MOSTLY  
BORN IN CANADA.

Ottawa, July 31.—In the event of Great Britain and Canada being involved in the European war it is of interest to note that there are at the present time about 200,000 natives of Austria-Hungary in Canada, while those of German origin total about 410,000. Most of these latter, however, are native Canadians, the German immigration to Canada since 1900 being only 35,000. The immigration from Austria-Hungary, however, has been very heavy during the past three years, totalling over 75,000. According to the last census the population of Austria-Hungarian origin is mainly in the prairie provinces. There are 41,000 in Saskatchewan, 39,000 in Manitoba and 26,000 in Alberta.
