

IMPUDENT FOREIGNERS ROUSE PUBLIC ANGER AT MEDICINE HAT

MEDICINE HAT, Aug. 5.—The Austrians and Germans here are in a sulky mood and with the aid of the liquor of which they are large consumers, tried the British spirit on numerous occasions tonight and serious rioting was narrowly averted.

Chief of Police Bruce, and his men are closely watching all the crowds, particularly a large one in front of a newspaper office, and the danger of the foreigners being beaten up for their impudence and imprudence is thus minimized.

The national and patriotic spirit of the city has been very strongly in evidence for the last few days.
