

AUSTRIANS CAN'T LEAVE CANADA

**Want to Fight for Country, But
No Ships Sailing—
Via U.S.?**

OTTAWA — Regulations forbidding the departure from Canada of Austrians and German reservists, who may desire to go to help these countries, will hardly be necessary. With all sailings across the Atlantic from Canadian ports completely stopped these men could not leave Canada, even if they wished to. They could proceed via the United States by United States vessels, though the United States might place technical difficulties in the way of their crossing the border. The government may take no action to stop the departure of these men via the United States. Their absence from Canada at the present juncture would be preferable to their presence.
