

GERMAN RESERVISTS FROM CANADA ARE ARRESTED IN LONDON

British Government Requisitioned all Aircraft in Kingdom

LONDON, Aug. 7.—German reservists from Canada were arrested yesterday on the arrival at Avonmouth of the steamship Royal George.

The British government has requisitioned all aircraft in the kingdom and is mobilizing them at the Hendon aerodrome.

Sentries at Dover fired on a man last night who was supposed to be tampering with the telephone system. The man escaped. Two suspected spies were arrested in London late last night.

Steamers between England and Denmark are expected to resume their sailings today.

The pastor of the German Seamen's mission at South Shields was arrested today.
