

Suspected Spy Shot to Death by
Guard on a Canadian Railway;

THE KILLED AS BRIDGE IS SET
THREE ON FIRE NEAR VAL CARTIER CAMP.

10.—Notification was received at the
From Star Sta. and Defence today of a daring out-
Ottawa, Aug. Lake St. John line north of Val
Department of Militia declares that "criminal hands"
rage on the Quebec and Lake St. John

The message is brief. It declares that "criminal hands"
have set fire to a bridge on the Quebec and Lake St. John
line and that a train has crashed through, killing three
people.

The message adds that an armed guard saw a sus-
picious character prowling round and shot him dead. No
doubt is entertained here as to what is implied by the
term "Criminal hands." "We know what that means a
this time, was the significant comment here." The action
of the guard in shooting to kill is an indication of what may
be expected if further attempts are made to interfere with
the line of communication.

The destruction of the bridge will not interfere with
the mobilization of the Overseas Division at Val Cartier.
The bridge is north of the camp.
