

SUSPECTED SPIES

NABBED AT HALIFAX

Halifax, N. S., Aug. 10.—Three Germans were taken prisoners this morning at Chester by three Halifax officers on the charge of being spies. The Germans got on the train at Hubbards and the officers were on the same train.

The baggage of the suspects was stopped. Papers and various plans found are said to confirm the suspicion that the Germans were acting as spies along the southern shore of Nova Scotia.

The prisoners will be brought to Halifax to-night. A suspicious character has also been arrested at Guysboro as a spy.
