

## GERMAN CONSUL RESIGNS.

Sydney, C. B., Aug. 15. — Robert Thomson, who has been Imperial German Consul for the counties of St. John, Charlotte, Westmoreland and Albert, N. B., has resigned the office. Mr. Thomson has been consul for the long term of thirty-six years. His imperial commission was signed by the first Emperor of Germany, Wilhelm, and countersigned by Baron Bulow. The royal ex-equator is signed by Queen Victoria and Lord Derby, all of whom have long since passed away.
