

FOREIGNERS WITH GUNS APPREHENDED AT COBALT

RAID THEY WERE GOING DUCK
SHOOTING, BUT WEAPONS
TAKEN.

Cobalt, Aug. 18.—While out searching for a man wanted in connection with an alleged burglary on Lang street, Constable Sharpe this morning about 6 o'clock encountered two **foreigners**, armed with guns, walking along the T. & N. O. tracks near the La Rose bridge. He took them to the police station, and later on they appeared before the Magistrate to account for their weapons.

The men, who are natives of Galicia and German Poland, explained that they had intended going duck shooting, which they had been told was particularly good at that time of the morning.

The Magistrate explained to them that in view of the international situation it was doubtful if **foreigners** who had not taken out naturalization papers, like themselves, would be permitted to carry guns at the present time, and he proposed to hold the weapons pending instructions from Ottawa.
