

# NANAIMO MINERS CALL OFF STRIKE

Vancouver, B.C., Aug. 26.—At a mass meeting of striking coal miners at Nanaimo last night the strike which has been conducted since May, 1912, by the United Mine Workers of America, was called off, and the men given the liberty to secure work in local mines should the companies accept them. Strike relief was stopped by the union six weeks ago, and realizing the futility of continuing the struggle without financial assistance the men by a large majority voted last night to call the strike off. As the mines of the district are working full force but a few of the striking miners will be able to secure employment and will be compelled to leave the city and seek work elsewhere.
