

PRISONERS OF WAR

Many Austrians Held In Canadian Village

BUFFALO, N.Y., Aug. 25.—A company of militia arrived at Bridgeburg, across the Niagara river from here, early today to guard 26 Austrians and Hungarians who had been taken from eastbound trains during the last few days. The foreigners were bound for New York, where they intended to secure passage to their native countries. The number of prisoners increased so rapidly that the village authorities were doubtful of their ability to hold them and asked for the militia. Niagara Falls, Ontario, has 15 prisoners of war, including German, Austrian and Hungarian reservists.
