

# GERMAN HID IN BOX CAR

## Said to Have Been Trying to Get Back to Germany

Found in a box car belonging to the Grand Trunk, Alwin Hertelt, a German, was arrested for loitering and will be sentenced on Wednesday by Judge St. Cyr. Hertelt was suspected of being a spy, especially when a book was found in his possession dealing with the preparation of ammunition. The prisoner explained that this book was supplied to every German soldier, and was not of a particularly dangerous character. It is thought that he was trying to make his way back to Germany. The Recorder's court was crowded with soldiers yesterday morning, four corporals' guards of five men each appearing to take charge of four soldiers, arrested for drunkenness by the city police. Two of them were in civilian clothes, the other two being in uniform. The latter came in for a severe rating from Recorder Temple for disgracing the King's uniform. They were turned over to the corporals' guard.
