

COMPLAIN OF GERMANS

Also Austrians Employed in Montreal Hotels.

MONTREAL, August 25.—Nearly 400 German and Austrian waiters and cooks employed in Montreal are occupying remunerative jobs, while men capable of the same class of work, belonging to the allies are out of employment. This was the complaint of English-speaking, French and Italian waiters, who have decided to bring to the notice of the president and directors of the large hotels the present conditions in an endeavor to have the Germans and Austrians replaced by subjects of the allies.
