

GERMAN'S FARM CONFISCATED.

Friedrich Budding Went Back To
Fight For His Country.

London, Ont., Sept. 3.—The immense fruit farm on the lake shore, purchased about a year ago by Friedrich Budding, a wealthy German, will be confiscated by the authorities. Budding disappeared mysteriously a few days before the war broke out, and it has been learned that he was a prominent German military officer, and that he is now fighting in France.
