

ARRESTED ON STEAMER, TO BE SENT TO CANADA

German Reservists Taken Off Boat Near New York by British Cruiser.

New York, Sept. 18.—The Dutch steamer *Commewijne*, from Cartagena and other ports in South and Central America, was stopped and searched off Ambrose Channel lightship this forenoon by the British cruiser *Lancaster*. Twenty-seven men the British officers decided were German reservists were taken off the ship and transferred to the cruiser.

Those arrested were discharged employes of the Hamburg-American line steamers *Albingia*, *Mecklenberg*, and *Virginia*, which are interned at Cartagena.

The prisoners were informed that they would probably be sent to detention camps in Canada.
