

100 ENEMIES AT FORT HENRY

**They Like the Treatment They Get
and Refuse to "Leave"**

Kingsion, Oct. 5.—Ten more prisoners of war were brought to Fort Henry during the week, making the total number here now two hundred. Three Germans were rounded up at Morrisburg, but two managed to make their escape. Evidence that the men like the treatment they are given in the Fort is shown in the case of one fellow who was allowed out on parole. He continued to loaf around in the vicinity of the Fort and wanted to get in again. It was necessary for an escort to take him in charge and see him off on one of the trains.
