

# LET THE JEW HELP BRITAIN

## Rev. S. B. Rohold Says They Should Pay Her Back.

Addresses on Home Mission work occupied the attention of the Presbyterian Synod at this morning's session. Rev. J. D. Byrnes told of the encouraging advance in the work among foreigners. Within the next fortnight both a Swedish Presbyterian Church and a Finnish Presbyterian Church are to be opened in the Haileybury district. Rev. A. E. Camp described the work among the Italians at Sault Ste. Marie.

Rev. S. B. Rohold, of the Toronto Jewish Mission, spoke feelingly of the tragedy confronting the Jewish race in this war. "Brother is fighting against brother; Jew against Jew." In the Russian army alone 220,000 Jews are fighting. He quoted, amid applause, the words of the Chief Rabbi of London: "Britain has done all it can for the Jews; let the Jews do all they can for Britain."
