

AUSTRIANS BLOW UP A BLOCK OF NINE TENEMENTS IN MONTRÉAL.

Montreal, Oct. 21.—Two unknown men, supposed to be Austrians, blew up with a bomb last night a block of nine tenements, inhabited largely by Russians, and three stores on Frontenac street.

One of the bomb throwers, unidentified, is dead in the morgue, and the body of the other is supposed to be in the ruins.

Two young men, Paul Beland Belanger and J. La Freniere, who were passing along Frontenac street at the time, saw two foreigners go into the hallway carrying a large black round thing. Immediately there was an explosion and the body of one came flying out through the doorway.

The building was completely wrecked. Two women are dying, one man is in a critical condition, four others are seriously and ten or a dozen slightly injured.
