## TEPS TAKEN TO STOP PRO-GERMAN PROPAGANDA

STRICTER CENSORSHIP WILL BE ESTABLISHED OVER PAPERS ENTERING AND IN CANADA.

(Special Despatch to The Globe.) Ottawa, Oct. 29.-The Government s taking steps to stop so far as posible a persistent pro-German and oro-Austrian agitation in some of the oreign settlements, particularly in western Canada, which might later on ead to dangerous outbreaks. A pro-German propaganda is being carried on wherever possible in Canada by German agents and sympathizers in the United States. German pamphlets printed in the English, German, Austrian and Hungarian languages are being mailed into Canada surreplitiously, and some articles of a decidedly pro-German character been appearing in a few of the German papers in the west, particularly in Alberta.

The Government intends to establish a considerably stricter censorship over the entry and publication of this sort of literature in Canada, and if warnings sent out to German editors in Canada are not observed, more dristle action will be promptly taken. As one step towards counteracting this pro-German propaganda all German papers in Canada will probably be required to publish in full the British white paper, setting forth the British will of the case and the causes of the war.
