

MORE PRISONERS TAKEN

Mounted Police Take Several to Fort Osborne Barracks

WINNIPEG, Nov. 2.—Between ten and twelve military prisoners, it is understood, have been brought to Winnipeg since Saturday night and interned at the Fort Osborne barracks. These prisoners, it is said, were all arrested in military district No. 10 by members of the R.N.W.M.P. force who brought them to Winnipeg. On Sunday night numerous members of this force were to be seen on the downtown streets.

It is rumored that this is only the first batch of a group of prisoners numbering almost thirty which have been arrested in the district.
