

LETTERS FROM WELLAND TOWNS SENT TO GERMANY VIA U. S. POST

Extra Guards Put on Canal Following Re- velation of Plot

St. Catharines, Nov. 2.—Reports
that a plot had been discovered to
blow up locks on the Welland Canal
led to-day to special attention being
applied to guarding the most vul-

nerable points on the waterway, al-
though no additional guards have
been placed there since Friday.

It has been discovered that mail
matter from this section has been
sent to and received from Germany
via the postoffice just across the
United States border, and the move-
ments of certain parties are being
watched closely.

The heads of the military guard
refused to-day to give any informa-
tion, saying that they did not desire
to show their hand.
