

FIFTY AUSTRIANS HELD UP SUNDAY

Came Down from Ft. William on Huronic and Escorted from Boat by Militia.

About fifty Austrians, comprising men, women and children, arrived in the city Sunday from Fort William on the Huronic, and were given a reception at the New Ontario Dock by the 51st Soo Rifles, and conducted to the armoury.

Six or seven of them are being detained by the regimental authorities, as they would not swear to keep the peace, but as the others were peaceable and agreed with the requests they were allowed their liberty.

When the Huronic was proceeding through the canal the foreigners were spied by the guards there, and were not allowed to land at the dock until a guard had arrived from the armoury.
