

MUST LEAVE CANADA

Turkish Ships Allowed Days of Grace
To Quit Dominion Ports

OTTAWA, Nov. 6.—Canada, with the rest of the Empire, is now at war with Turkey. A proclamation is being issued providing the usual period of days of grace for Turkish ships in Canadian waters, as provided under The Hague convention. The proclamation is not much more than a formality in Canada as Turkish ships are infrequent visitors.

Whatever trade has existed between Canada and Turkey will stop, but it is so small as to be almost negligible. It is not large enough to have a place on the government returns under a separate head, but is included under "other countries."
