Post Office Authorities to Take Action to Control Distribution

OTTAWA, Ont., Nov. 12.—Street sales in Canada of pro-German publications, foreign or otherwise, is now being investigated by the post office authorities and definite action to restrain a distribution of offensive publications will be taken in a few days. By the order in council, recently passed, dealing with such papers, authority was conferred upon the post office authorities to control their circulation by any method, and making it a criminal offense to sell them or have them in their possession. Under this wide authority the officials will take action to control the distribution of these publications.
