

**Polish Training School Principal.**—The position of principal of the Polish training school, made vacant by the resignation of Adam Bloch, is filled by an appointment of Martin Murphy, of Montreal, who for some years was a professor of the Jesuits college in the Quebec capital. After the new year an assistant principal will be appointed to teach students Polish literature and history. Rev. Kowalski, parish priest of the Holy Ghost church, will teach Catholic ethics as in previous years. The lessons are being held in the Normal school on William avenue. The old school building on Beaconsfield street is serving as dormitory and feeding place. There are in all 14 students at the present time, of whom eight, after the new year, will become teachers in Polish Cana-

dian settlement. This opens vacancies  
for new pupils.
