

# TORONTO ALIENS TO BE DISCHARGED FROM CIVIC SERVICE

## Board of Control Instructions Affect Dr. Kohlman, Ger- man Reservist

TORONTO, Nov. 16.—Peremptory orders were given by the board of control last Friday to the chief civic officials to immediately discharge any Germans, Austrians or Turks they have employed in their respective departments. This was the outcome of a strong protest made by Alderman McBride against the detention of Dr. Kohlman, a German reservist, in the works department. The doctor has been employed as an engineer on drainage work for the last two years, and Works Commissioner Harris gave him a very good character, saying he had retained him in the department after consultation with the police and military authorities. When the war broke out Dr. Kohlman was put on parole, and reported to the authorities regularly.

Within a half hour of the passage of the board's order Dr. Kohlman quit his post.
