Mr. C. H. Speer, secretary of the local relief committee, has a large number of unemployed persons on his records in the city engineer's office, City Hall.

Mr. Speer says that with the advent of winter weather a great many applications for work have been made to him and that he has now no work to give to those persons who are asking for it and more than willing to earn it honestly.

Talking over the matter Mr. Speer commented that when he drew the fact to the attention of the people of the Sault some time ago through the Star that he was in a position to supply men to odd jobs such as putting on storm windows and looking after furnaces, he had a great many applications for men to do such work. He still is in a position to furnish men for this kind of work, and besides has carpenters, bakers, cooks, errand boys, maids and stenographers who are in need of work.
