

TURKS ARRESTED

AT KINGSGATE, B.C.

Attempted to Cross Line After
Being Paroled by Mounted
Police at McLeod.

MacLeod, Alta., Nov. 25. — Three Turkish missionaries, Ziha Thomas, Alexander Kuriakos and Elias Marcus, who were recently held by the mounted police as prisoners of war but later released on parole on condition that they did not leave this country, were arrested by the immigration officials at Kingsgate, B.C., as they attempted to cross into the United States. They were at once sent back to MacLeod and later to the detention camp at Lethbridge until the termination of the war. When first arrested they claimed to be collecting funds for the relief of Christians in Turkey and satisfied the authorities that they were genuine missionaries.
