

CANADIAN MILITIA- MAN CHARGED WITH TREASON

On a charge of high treason against the empire, Paul Mazur, a young Canadian corporal in the Canadian militia, born of Austrian parents, was sent up from police court to the assizes at Toronto on Tuesday.

W. K. Murphy, jr., his counsel, put up a plea that the young fellow was going to visit in the States and did not deliberately attempt to smuggle three Austrians out of Canada, as charged by the Crown.

An interesting feature of the case was that Mazur was acting as interpreter in enrolling alien enemies at Port Hope. He was caught at Niagara with three Austrians crossing the border.
