

# GOVERNMENT PLANS FOR INTERNING THE ALIENS MATURING

Areas of Crown Lands to be  
Set Aside Where They  
Can be Put to Work.

Ottawa, Nov. 27.—The Government's plans for the internment of aliens are rapidly maturing and are likely to be announced very shortly. The Province of Quebec, it is understood, has agreed to the proposal of setting apart areas of its Crown lands upon which these foreigners would be put to work in clearing operations, and arrangements will be made as quickly as possible to move to such locations the two classes affected by the order—those who are a menace to the community, and those who, being out of work, but unable to go home, are public charges. Ontario, to which a similar proposition has been submitted has not yet finally replied.

In the west the aliens would be assigned to similar labor in Dominion park lands. They would build shanties, cut firewood and engage generally in clearing operations, while should the land prove suitable, they might eventually live there if developing peaceful intentions. As soon as the plan can be put in operation, those who are public charges in the cities and towns will be promptly sent to the concentration camps. The one in Quebec will likely be located in Abitibi, on the high Gatineau.

Germans and Austrians and others of enemy nationality in Canada have registered under the Government's regulations to the approximate number of 25,000, and the registration work is in satisfactory progress. So far no difficulty has been experienced in carrying out the order; in fact the aliens have readily volunteered to register.
