THEY WERE ALIENS. The Soldiers Sent Home Are Not Canadians. Qitawa, Dec. 2.-The statement that all persons of German descent in the

first Canadian contingent at Salis-Plain have been discharged from the force was corrected by the government. Word received by Major-General Hughes is to 'the effect that thirty-

eight persons have been discharged and that not one of these is a Canadian citizen born or naturalized. They were for the greater part enlisted in Western Canada, some from the Unit-

edeStates, and are of German or Austrian origin. In any event, what-has happened will not prevent the recruiting of German-Canadians for further contingents, though every precaution will be taken in colistment.
