

"The Germans in Vancouver"—Addressing his congregation on "The Germans in Vancouver," Rev. J. K. Unsworth, pastor of the First Congregational church, last night said that of the 11,000 Germans reported as living in Canada in 1911, only about 3000 were left. Of 8000 reported to be living in Vancouver only 600 or 700 now remained in the city. Nearly 100 were interned in detention stations at Nanaimo and Vernon, where they were treated fairly. Nearly 1000 aliens were registered at the city police station, and of these 214 were Germans who had to report at stated periods. Mr. Unsworth said, however, that there were more dread enemies in Vancouver than were Germans, and he called for volunteers in the fight to ensure a clean bill of civic health.
