

Alien Arrested As He Boards Train

German Had Telegram in Possession, and Police Will Inquire

Heinrich Kahl, a German, was arrested last night at the Union Station as he was boarding a train to go to New York. He was charged with a breach of the Military Act and was handed over to the military authorities. He was examined by Register of Aliens Judge Coatsworth to-day.

In the man's possession was found a telegram from New York bearing the following words:—

"Come at once. Position waiting. I want you.

"Did I"

Although the telegram would seem to indicate that the man to whom it was despatched is asked to go to a job that is waiting for him, the police are somewhat suspicious of the signature at the bottom and are trying to fathom its meaning. Kahl will be interned until they are successful.
