

ALIEN ENEMIES ARE SENT TO PETAWAWA

First Quota of 200 Today. La Tuque Concentration Camp Opens Next Week.

The internment of alien enemies at Petawawa is to begin today. In addition to the hundred being taken from Montreal a similar number are going from Kingston. Eventually about 500 are to be located at Petawawa and detailed for work such as road building and clearing. They will get their keep and an allowance of 25 cents per day for tobacco and such luxuries.

It is the plan of General Citer to open within a week the Quebec concentration camp at Parent, near La Tuque, and another large quota will be sent there. In carrying out this policy the government is not only taking care of those who may be a menace to the community because of hostile intentions, but incidentally providing employment for large numbers who otherwise would become charges upon the municipality.

No difficulty in handling the interned squads is anticipated. They will be effectively guarded to prevent any possibility of outbreak, but in place of evincing a desire to make trouble their attitude is quite the contrary, and a willingness to readily submit to the regulations is reported by those who have them in charge.
