

EXERCISE DR. KOHLMAN.

Stanley Barracks Guards Give Him Hour's Constitutional.

Dr. Ervin Kohlman, late of the Civic Works Department, who was arrested Friday night as he was attempting to leave the city, is still in Stanley Barracks with other prisoners of war. Judge Coatsworth, in charge of the alien registration bureau, has asked Ottawa for instructions in the matter. The letter from Premier Sir Robert Borden, authorizing Kohlman to cross the border, is now in Judge Coatsworth's possession.

Dr. Kohlman received the same treatment as any other prisoner at Stanley Barracks. He was given a walk for about an hour's time this morning and told one of the officers that he enjoyed it very much.

Up to date between 500 and 600 aliens have registered at the bureau in Adelaide street east. Some of these are required to report weekly, others twice a month, and others monthly, according to circumstances. If an alien is of a suspicious character, or is out of work, he is taken into custody and sent to Stanley Barracks.
