

Prisoners Leave For New Ontario

Will be Sent to Point on Na- tional Transcontinental Railway

To-morrow a considerable number of alien prisoners now interned in Stanley Barracks will leave under a strong guard for New Ontario. Col. H. M. Elliot told *The Daily News* this morning that orders for their removal were received from Major-General Otter to-day. These men will not go to Algonquin Park, as was originally suggested, but will be placed at a point along the National Transcontinental Railway, where they will be engaged in the opening of township lines and concession roads, and similar development work. Those leaving will make considerably more room at the Barracks, and the arrival of another batch of suspects can consequently be expected shortly, as the intention of the militia authorities is to use Stanley Barracks as a general receiving station for alien prisoners in this military division.
