

German Lecturer Gives up Position

Herr W. A. Von Lubtow, of Trinity College, Has Resigned

Herr W. A. von Lubtow, lecturer in German at Trinity College, has resigned his position on the staff. Yesterday the Corporation of Trinity College met and accepted it. Herr von Lubtow, it is said, will now join the staff of an American University.

Regarding this matter Provost Macklem, when interviewed, stated that the German lecturer had acted admirably throughout: that he had realized that the presence of a German citizen on Trinity teaching staff was not right during the war, and had early placed the matter in the Corporation's hands, in spite of the fact that he is quite pro-British himself.
