Memorandum for the Prime Minister

MINISTERS OFFICE

Since under the Order in Council of October 2nd 1914, published in an Extra of the Canada Gazette, October 5th 1914, Canadian patents held by enemy subjects are not to be voided or suspended generally but only on certain conditions named therein, the annexed Order in Council, proposed by the Deputy Minister of Agriculture, would seem to be proper and indeed necessary. Further, the Order as drafted follows the terms of the license granted by the British Board of Trade as it appears in the London Gazette of November 6th.
