

# REGISTRATION CARDS ARE BEING RETURNED PROPERLY FILLED OUT

Ottawa, Jan. 2---This is national registration week, and already the incoming mailbags are filled with cards containing replies to the twenty-four questions put to all Canadian males between the ages of eighteen and sixty-five by the National Service Commission. The replies received so far are those from men living within one day's travel of the capital. A steadily increasing volume of replies is anticipated until the early part of next week when it is expected that all the cards will be in with the exception of those from the most distant points.

The National Service Commission already has a considerable staff engaged in preliminary work in connection with the tabulation of the returns. The cards so far received do not reveal any unwillingness on the part of Canadian manhood to frankly answer all the twenty-four questions asked. The replies in practically all cases are frank and open.
