

Examines Cases of Imprisoned Aliens

Consider Which to Intern and Which to Parole on Release

Captain Wandless, Assistant Registrar of Alien Enemies, went to the jail farm at Mimico on Saturday afternoon to examine three alien enemies detained there. He took particulars of each, on which Judge Coatsworth will decide what course to adopt at the time of their release. Erich Michberg was sentenced for carrying concealed arms, an auto pistol and a hunting knife; Nick Borgage, an Austrian, for playing cards on Sunday; and Otto Marian, German, 34 years in Canada, for a serious offence. At first Marian declared that he was a Canadian citizen, this he afterwards denied. It is not yet announced who of these will be paroled and who interned at the expiration of the sentences.
