DECOMING SERIOUS

Ottawa, Jan. 16.—General Sir William Otter has found it necessary to go to Fort William and Port Arthur to deal with the alien enemy situation which has become rather serious. No less than 1,400 aliens have been registered in the twin cities,

most of whom will be interned. The problem confronting the authorities is to provide work for them, more particularly as it is not considered desirable to have them compete with Canadian labor. A number of aliens will probably be sent to clear the experamental farm in North Ontario. Others will be sent to a camp to be established in the west. General
