

TORONTO YOUTH WANTED ON CHARGE OF AIDING ALIEN ENEMY'S ESCAPE

Made His Departure Into States
on Hearing that Police Were
Seeking Him.

Toronto, Jan. 23.—Emile Nerlich, 16 Dunbar road, Rosedale, of the firm of Nerlich and company, wholesale fancy goods, etc., with head offices at 148 Front street, is being sought by the Toronto authorities, by whom he is wanted on a charge of aiding an alien enemy to escape. He is now thought to be in the United States, but his exact location is unknown.

Mr. Nerlich apparently heard that the Toronto police wanted him and left the city some time between 4 o'clock and 8 o'clock last Sunday by automobile.

He was a naturalized citizen of Canada and therefore would have no difficulty crossing the border.

The charge on which he is wanted grew out of the attempted escape last Friday of a lieutenant in the German army. This lieutenant was arrested on a train at the Union station. At the time he denied that he was a reservist but papers found in his trunk showed he was not only a reservist but that he had been in communication with German officers in the United States and Germany for several months. He is now interned in the detention camp at Stanley Barracks. Other papers found in his possession showed that he was attempting to reach the United States in order to join his regiment in Germany.
