

ALIEN ENEMIES WORK IN INTERNMENT CAMPS

Reports from the internment camp at Kapuskasing, Ont., on the C.T.R., tell of weather 52 degrees below zero, but the Austrians and Germans are well clothed and fed, and the work has gone on without interruption. There have been no serious disorders at any of the camps.

It is intended eventually to have at least a thousand men at both the Kapuskasing and Spirit Lake camps.
