

PREPARE LISTS OF THOSE UNREGISTERED

Several Hundred Aliens, it is
Stated, Have Not Put in
Appearance

WILL BE ROUNDED UP

Notice for Reporting Before
the End of Febru-
ary

Two of the alien enemies who had been registered at the office of Registrar for aliens were arrested last night for failure to report regularly and these arrests are to be followed by the interment of about fifteen more men for the same reason.

A list is being prepared by Captain Wandless, of the Registration office, of those who have apparently disappeared and they will be rounded up by the police immediately. Some of these men have not reported at the office since the early part of January.

According to Captain Wandless, about 3,000 alien enemies have been registered, but about five hundred more have failed to respond to the order to appear. Steps are to be taken to secure the signatures of these men or they will be interned, regardless of position or standing. There have been really no disappearances from the city, it is said, but neglect to report means internment for the period of war.

February Reporting.

Some difficulty was experienced this morning at the registration office to make the men understand that if they were required to report once a month that they would have to attend at the bureau next on February 27th, if they had been in the habit of coming on the 28, 29 or 30 of this or previous months. The reason for the confusion is that February is the short month, and moreover, the 28th or last day of February, falls on a Sunday. Accordingly, February 27th, will be a very busy day at the bureau, it is expected.
