

WORKING UP CASE FOR HORN.

**Pro-German Irishman, His Counsel,
Off to New York.**

Machias, Me., Feb. 9.—Daniel T. O'Connell, attorney for Werner Horn, the bridge dynamiter who is serving a term of thirty days in the county jail here, went to New York to-day to obtain possession of a trunk left by Horn at a hotel on Staten Island. Mr. O'Connell said that documents in the trunk would establish Horn's claim that he was a German officer and that his attempt to destroy the Canadian end of the St. Croix River bridge was a political and not a criminal act.
