Paul Mazur, acquitted on the first charge of high treason in Canada for seventy-five years, was not alfor seventy-five years, was not al-lowed to go home with his mother last night, as his counsel, Mr. W. K. Murphy, Jr., pleaded for him. He was held in jail at the order of the Registrar of Alene Enemies that he might attend at his office to-day for the question of his interment to be considered, and his egistration as an allen enemy, made and

considered, and his registration as an alien enemy made.

Mazur claimed, before the trial, that he was a Canadian, having been born at Yorktown, Sask. At the vial it transpired that he was born h Austria, being taken to Yorktown

h Austria, being taken to Yorktown when he was three-and-a-half year-old. As he is not known to have taken out naturalization papers, he comes within the jurisdiction of the Registrar, who is inclined to take umbrage at his confessed attempt to leave the country and to assist three-registered allen enemies to leave registered

No Second Trial.

The Registrar learned this morning that Maxur (or, Grammer, which is his baptismal name) is being held by the Crown also on the other charge sustained against him by the

Grand Jury—that of high treason. He was tried for conspiring to com-mit that offence.

mit that offence.

There will be no second trial, it is stated. The same ovidence will be allowed and the Crown will consent to a repetition of the Jury's finding last night—not guility. This will delay Mazur's registration and possible internment.
