Charge Against Him Never Came to · Trial: Controllers Restore Him.

London. Ont., Feb. 10.-General Manager Henry J. Glaubitz of the Utilities Commission was to-day reinstated in his position, which he

vacated several weeks ago. Glaubitz was made an issue of the municipal elections in January. opposing his holding of the position on the ground of his German birth and alleged pro-German sympathies were elected by great maiorities. One of the charges made Glaubitz was that he had assisted a German reservist named Becker, omployed in the Utilitles Commission, to return to Germany. The charge was

never brought to trial. The Board of Control this morning voted three to two to reinstate Mr. Glaubitz.
