

MAY AMALGAMATE ALL RIFLE ASSOCIATIONS

Movement Now on Foot to
Unify All Civilian
Bodies.

A movement is now on foot to amalgamate all the rifle associations in Toronto, having a total membership of about 10,000, and to put them under one head. The scheme, however, is only in its preliminary stages, and no definite steps have been taken as yet. It is likely that if a reorganization was made, the 3,500 Winchester rifles which were purchased by the city will be re-distributed.

Private Arthur Smith, of the 13th Battalion, Hamilton, who is in the General Hospital with meningitis, the only case that has arisen at the Exhibition camp, was reported to be holding his own. Lieut.-Col. J. T. Fotheringham, medical director, today said his recovery was problematical.

The number of cases of influenza and mumps is decreasing, and the camp is rapidly gaining a clean bill of health. There are 25 cases of mumps and some cases of tonsillitis. The dentists are concluding their work, and by the end of the week the teeth of all the men will be in fine shape.

The work of vaccinating the men of the third contingent against smallpox is proceeding. Every man of the 25th, 26th, and 37th Battalions will have been vaccinated before the men

are concentrated. The move was decided on when a case of smallpox was found in the Cayuga third contingent detachment.

Major W. P. Butcher has started the course of instruction for the officers of the Machine-gun Battery, in the use of machine-guns.

The 48th Highlanders and 10th Royal Grenadiers sent a detachment of 60 men to Stanley Barracks to take over the duties there and relieve the men of the Royal Canadian Dragoons. They will also supply the guards for different points in the city.

Want a Public Lavatory.

Property Commissioner Chisholm has been requested by residents in the Queen street and Kingston road districts to recommend the building of a public lavatory at that point, as it is the junction of the city and radial lines.
